Hornøya – a bird watching paradise

Hornøya is Norway's easternmost island and is located just over one kilometer outside Vardø in the Barents Sea. Hornøya is easily accessible, just a 10-minute boat ride from the Vardø harbor. On your way to Hornøya you will get a good first impression of Hornøya's rich bird life. There are many birds on the island that are either on their way out or in from the fish rich Arctic Ocean to obtain food.

When we arrive at Hornøya you are dropped off just below the bird mountain. The bird mountain is easily accessible and has a wide variety of species. You will find, for example, Europe's most easily accessible colony of Brünnich's guillemots, a species that only nests in arctic areas.

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The bird population on the island is unique. You will also see seabirds such as puffins, razorbills, common guillemots, black-legged kittiwake's, great comorants, black guillemots, European shag and European storm-petrels. On the flatter parts of Hornøya, large numbers of herring gulls, mew gulls and the great black-backed gull can be seen. Hornøya and Varangerfjord are one of the most important wintering areas for the arctic duck species and king eider.

Unlike the scanty arctic landscape on the northern part of the Varangerhalvøya, Hornøya has a lush vegetation which is the result of the rich fertilization from the birds on the island. Furthermore, Hornøya is a nature reserve. Because of that there is restricted traffic and a limited number of visitors on the island. A marked trail ensures that all species on the island can be seen, and you will be able to observe most of them up close.

Bring a pack of nuts, something hot to drink and don't forget your camera! Use only the trail and do not disturb the birds unnecessarily.

It can also be arranged to have tours of 2 hours to see the King Eider and tours to Syltefjordstauran which has the largest colony of gannets. This must be booked in advance.

Fishing trips Monday – Friday: between 09:00 – 17:00

If necessary, we can also arrange trips outside these departure times. Including whale watching.

Duration: 2 hours.

Price:

NOK 700,- per person, children pay half the price and for groups of over 15 persons it will be NOK 350,- per person.

Price of renting a boat including a driver: minimum of NOK 2100,- per trip. Price per hour for trips longer than 2 hours costs NOK 350,- per person.

The tours depart from the steamship quay at the tourist information office.

Overnight stay in the lighthouse keeper's house on Hornøya

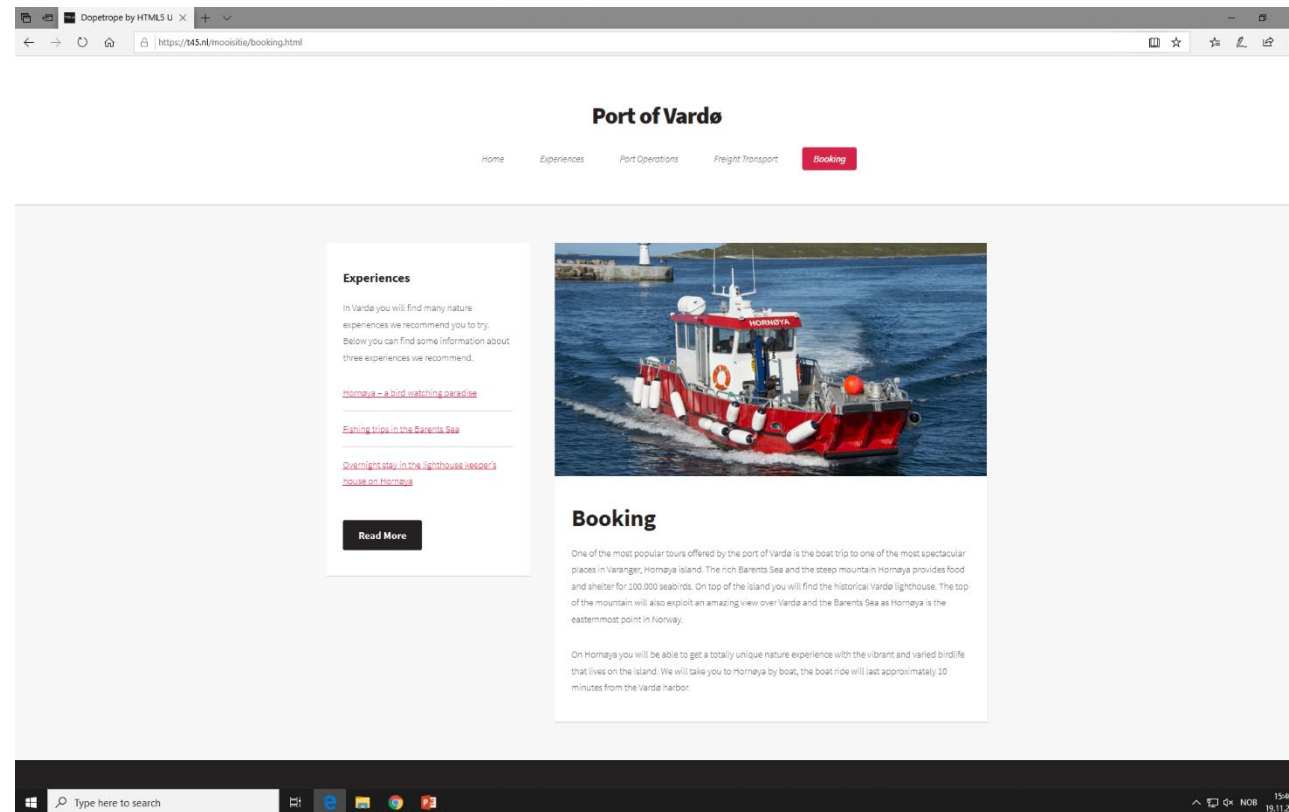
We also offer accommodation in the lighthouse keeper's house at Vardø Fyr, with simple and great nature experiences. The lease is based on the principle of self-service.

The accommodation includes a shared kitchen with electric cooker and fridge, toilet and shower.

Fresh water is sparse on Hornøya, so guests are asked to moderate the consumption of water. The rooms that can be rented have 2 and 4 beds. There are only mattresses in the beds, but bed linen can be rented, too.

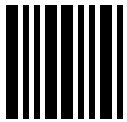
